

# 'Spirit of Pahat' / Steel Sculptures



'Spirit of Pahat' is the artist's interpretation and rendition of **California's first fossilized, 25 million year old toothed baleen whales, *Ojaicetus plunkettidens***, discovered in Ojai, CA, land of the Chumash, 1/19/2000 – 'Pahat' is the Chumash word for whale.

Perched on a 'wave', the whale can be adjusted to accommodate your artistic/aesthetic preference. You can re-position the whale to point in either direction, as well as different vertical angles of your choosing with its multi-directional cradle mounting system and easy to move base. 'Spirit of Pahat' is constructed from medium density steel and available in 3 sizes and finishes; Ancient (naturally oxidized metal/pictured above, right); Modern (polished metal/pictured above, left); or Pre-historic Bone (painted patina).
